



FORT FREMONT HISTORY SERIES

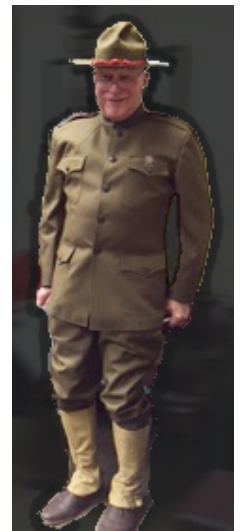
Fort Fremont was built in 1898 on St. Helena Island to defend the U.S. Naval Station, Port Royal, on Parris Island. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
